What is the Data Warehouse?

The Data Warehouse is a multi-agency data analysis system that has been designed so that the Derby City Partnership can develop a better and shared understanding of the needs and aspirations of Derby's neighbourhoods and communities. It enables identification of areas or communities for resource and service targeting.

The Data Warehouse brings together a wide range of data from partner organisations, and local surveys, into a "one stop shop" for local information. It currently holds local information on crime, education, childcare, health, employment, demographics, annual earnings, household expenditure and lifestyle patterns. The range and volume of data held in the Data Warehouse is expanding daily.

How can the Data Warehouse Help You?

The Data Warehouse...

- Enables members of the Derby City Partnership - DCP - to store, retrieve and analyse high quality neighbourhood information using a unified, consistent and secure system.
- Can handle virtually any statistical or survey data. Therefore, all socio-economic data profiling or area-based performance monitoring for local, regional or national requirements can be supported through the system both now and in the future.
- Gives users full control over access to their data
- Facilitates information sharing and the development of the shared understanding of local conditions and priorities.
- Enables data to be reported for any geography, including custom areas such as school catchments.
- Reduces overlap and duplication of effort in data collection.
- Simplifies the creation of monitoring reports and baseline statistics.
- Delivers recognisable benefits in evidence based planning for policy development and targeting of resources.
- Supports the projection of future need.
