Action Plan: Strategic Objectives

- To support the development of a creative industries cluster through the provision and refurbishment of facilities and incubator units in the City Centre
- The development of inner city businesses, services and facilities in the inner city areas and in particular the city centre by redeveloping key sites and carrying out environmental improvements to enhance the 'Urban Offer'
- To strengthen Derby's competitiveness by supporting the development needs, including ICT, of growth sectors and inner city businesses including social enterprises
- To assist local people in the most deprived areas of Derby access the new employment opportunities by building capacity of local communities and developing facilities & services
- To improve & develop services, facilities and cultural events for tourists & visitors to the city centre
