Introduction

This agreement is a voluntary commitment to positive and clear working practices by partners and partnership teams. Its aim is to improve relationships, communication, participation and services to create a better Derby.

Purpose of Derby City Partnership

The purpose of Derby City Partnership is to deliver the 2020 Vision - to make Derby the pride of East Midlands - and to promote neighbourhood renewal in disadvantaged parts of Derby. It aims to be an independent public, private, voluntary and community sector based partnership that adds value and inspires change through positive partnership working.

To deliver its vision, Derby City Partnership has six priorities:

- A stimulating and high quality learning environment.
- Healthy, safe and independent communities.
- A lively and energetic cultural life.
- A diverse, attractive and healthy environment.
- A prosperous, vibrant and successful economy.
- A shared commitment to regenerating our communities.

The Partnership Agreement commits partners to:

- working towards the common aim of Derby City Partnership - that is the well being of Derby and its people
- bringing about change through creative and high quality approaches
- being accountable to their organisation, to other partners and to the people of Derby
- feeding back Derby City Partnership business and decisions to the organisation or network they represent
- promoting equality, celebrating diversity and making sure people of different backgrounds have similar life opportunities
- showing respect and tolerance for other people's views
- clear communication that is free of jargon
- sharing skills and promoting learning
- contributing to consultation where appropriate
- contributing positively to making meetings successful
- avoiding conflict and complaint by open and positive relationships
- respecting confidentiality
- monitoring and evaluating our performance.

The Partnership aims to have balanced representation from all sectors where appropriate and possible. It also aims to support the 2020 Vision through prioritisation of external funding and relevant service budgets.

It is the responsibility of all partners to promote the principles within this agreement and to measure the effectiveness of the agreement in contributing to the improvement of services and facilities in Derby.
